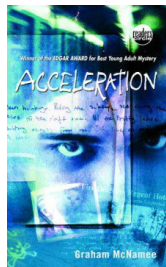


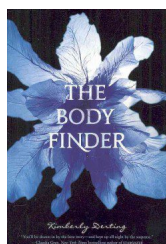

by Graham McNamee

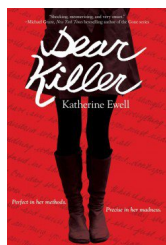

by Katherine Ewell

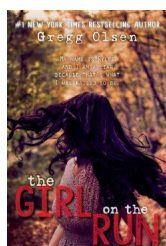

by Tsugumi Ohba

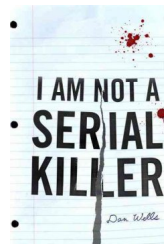

by Gregg Olsen

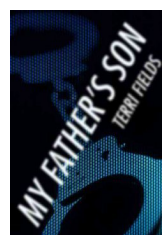

by Terri Fields

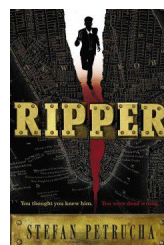

by Elle Cosimano

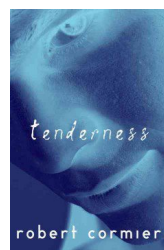
A math-whiz from a trailer park discovers she's the only student capable of unravelling complex clues left by a serial killer who's systematically getting rid of her classmates.
