previous year returns or amendments
should schedule an appointment for later
in the tax season.

Be sure to bring ...

- Picture ID (such as a valid driver's license or other government-issued ID) for you and your spouse
- Social security cards or ITIN letters for you and all persons on your tax return
- Tax documentation such as Forms W-2, 1099 (SSA, R, INT, DIV), 1095 (A, B, C), and 1098 for you and your dependents
- A copy of last year's tax return
- Bank account numbers for direct deposit on a printed check or bank card
- Potential deductions such as medical, mortgage, and charitable expenses
