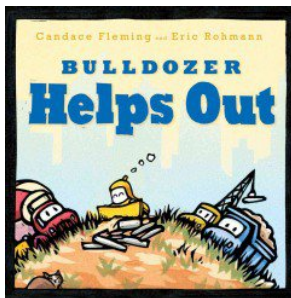


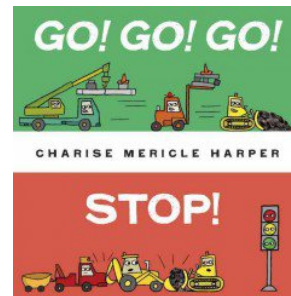

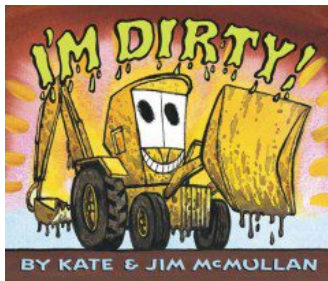
Bulldozer Helps Out by Candace Fleming

Little Bulldozer tackles a debris-clearing job only to discover a litter of newborn kittens who prove more difficult to care for than anticipated.



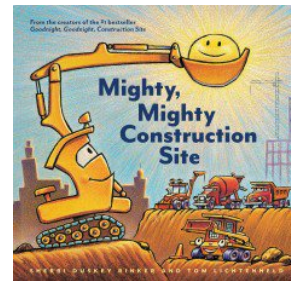
Go! Go! Go! Stop! by Charise Mericle Harper

The story of Little Green, who contributes to an increasingly frenzied construction project.



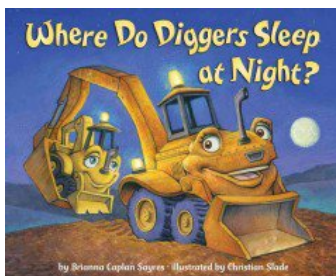
I'm Dirty! by Kate McMullan

Youngsters are invited to spend the day working in the dirt with a little backhoe loader who absolutely loves his job, as he digs, pulls, pushes and chops!



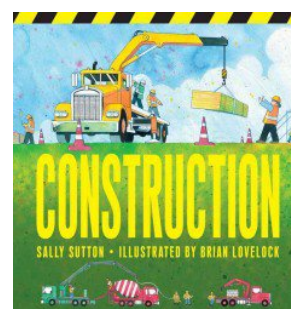
Mighty, Mighty Construction Site by Sherri Duskey Rinker
