- **For Safety Reasons: PLEASE do not enter after movie has begun**

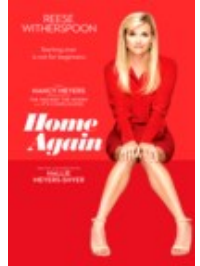
