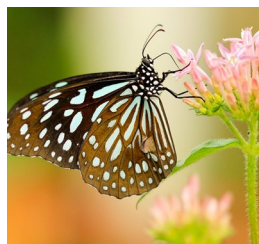


# Chatham Public Library

**Fridays at 10:15am**

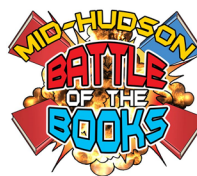

5pm**

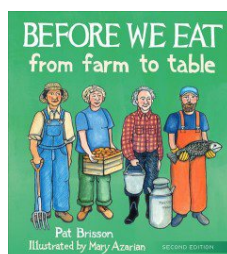
Attend our informational and planning meeting for the 2018 Battle of the Books. **(For students entering 6th through 9th grade)**
